Changes in the Sector

- The importance and prominence of EDI in the sector Unheard of concept 15 to 20 years ago...business critical, today!
- Greater innovation and creativity Different approaches to grant-making, for example, with greater community involvement (PGMs) and approaches to power and philanthropy.
- More well-rounded approach to charity stewardship e.g. focus on social conscience and regard to charitable objects in ALL aspects of governance, as seen in new CC14.
- Changes to management approach –increased focus on wellbeing, hybrid and flexible working plus more emphasis on a balanced approach to performance appraisal e.g. 360 feedback



Role of the Finance Team

• Adaptability – Finding ways to ensure internal controls are comprehensive but not restrictive e.g. Covid crisis fund

• Review **financial regulations** at least annually – What is/isn't working? Where do you have too little or, even, too much control in place?

- Not just finance! Getting out of our silos and **understand** the needs of your teams and beneficiaries.
- Change in **recruitment** focus Are your JDs preventing you from accessing the right talent?
- **Performance Management** Link these to your corporate strategy. Balance operational targets with strategic need and career development.
- Be an **enabler** for change rather than a blocker e.g. incorporating responsible investment strategies.
- Finance professionals are important advocates for **accountability** in strategy, EDI and all aspects of charity management.
